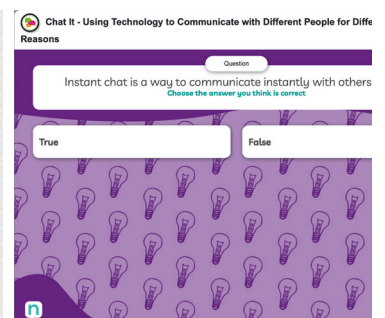
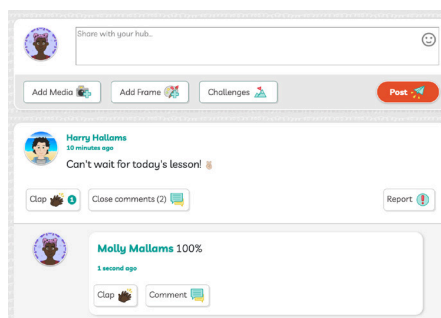
Why Natterhub?
